Born- 6 august 1881, lochfield Scotland

Died- 11 march 1995 (aged 73)

Educated- Loudoun Moor then moved to Kilmarnock Academy in 1894

Famous- the bacteriologist who discovered penicillin

Legacy- his drug/medicine is used for treatment on various occasions

Social Background- He died rich because his discovery saved many lives.

Discovered- In 1928, Alexander Fleming discovered mould on a plate that was keeping bacteria away, so he investigated the mould and discovered a drug called penicillin, which saved millions of lives!!

Awards- Noble Prize in physiology or medicine (1945)
